NEW LEARNING RESOURCE FROM LOCAL AUTHOR

Local author Michele Graham, in collaboration with educational specialist and fellow author Jade Sercombe-Ford, has launched a digital learning resource and children's activity kit to complement her picture book, "*Millie Finds Her Voice*".

Millie Finds Her Voice is a heartfelt exploration of childhood trauma. It features beautiful illustrations and a narrative that encourages meaningful conversations between children and adults.

The digital learning resource includes interactive, visually engaging activities designed to reinforce the book's important messages. Key features of the resource include:

- **Lesson Plans** aligned with the Australian Curriculum and the Early Years Learning Framework.
- **Lesson Activities** that focus on emotional awareness and expression, understanding and creating safe spaces, developing communication skills, and promoting resilience and safety awareness.

The resource is available free to Australian schools and public libraries. Michele Graham said, "I wanted to provide a free and easily accessible tool for teachers and educators." She emphasised that "equipping educators, parents, and caregivers with tools that help facilitate essential conversations can help foster safer environments for children in schools, daycares, and homes across Moreton Bay."
